All food waste including:
meat, fish, & bones
egg shells
tea bags & coffee grounds
all fruits & vegetables
cooking oil & fat
paper drinking cups (lids go in the blue or clear bags)

Soiled and/or wet paper including:
pizza boxes
waxed boxes
paper towels
waxed paper
napkins
non-metallic wrapping paper (i.e. birthday, Christmas, etc)
leaves, brush & weeds
sawdust & wood shavings
plants
grass clippings

No plastics, metals, or glass in the green cart.
Biodegradable bags must bear this logo:

Recyclables - Blue/Clear Bags

Paper Products
newspaper
paper egg cartons
cardboard
(can be flattened and tied into bundles no more than 2ft x 3ft)
boxboard (i.e. cereal boxes)
phone books
catalogues
paper including shredded
flyers & magazines
soft cover books
hard cover books (interior pages only, covers to be disposed of in garbage)
empty paper towel rolls
empty toilet paper rolls
cigarette packages (foil removed)

Containers
glass jars & bottles
beer & liquor bottles
pop & water bottles
juice & milk cartons
grocery bags
plastic food bags
shampoo bottles
plastic tubs & lids
cleaning fluid bottles
all other plastics 1-7
steel tin food cans
aluminum foil
aluminum pie plates
aluminum cans
tetra pak containers
yogurt and pudding cups
plastic wrap

All recyclables should be clean and dry.



Use blue or clear bags only.

All bags must be securely tied.

Do not use grocery bags as containers.
(they go in the blue or clear bags)

styrofoam
toothpaste tubes
potato chip bags
toys
CD's & DVD's
clothing & footwear
lightbulbs
broken bottles
cookware
empty motor oil containers
disposable diapers
candy wrappers
drinking glasses

heat treated & window glass
personal hygiene products
vacuum cleaner bags
metallic giftwrap
dryer sheets & lint
frozen juice cans
wallpaper
empty aerosol cans

No organics, recyclables or construction/demolition materials in waste bags.

Use black or green bags ONLY.

Do NOT use grocery bags or feed type bags.
